





Non-natural / Pending Manners of Death



AUTOPSIES

Slightly more than 8% of all deaths will have a forensic autopsy, which is a postmortem examination of a decedent whose death falls under the jurisdiction of the medical examiner. A forensic autopsy is a component of the medicolegal death investigation that can be utilized to identify the decedent, assist in determining the cause and manner of death, identify additional factors that contributed to death, collect evidence to be used in criminal and civil trials, identify natural diseases that may affect family members, and provide further information that can help the decedent's family process their grief.

Slightly more than 8% of all deaths will have a forensic autopsy, which is a postmortem examination of a decedent whose death falls under the jurisdiction of the medical examiner. A forensic autopsy is a component of the medicolegal death investigation that can be utilized to identify the decedent, assist in determining the cause and manner of death, identify additional factors that contributed to death, collect evidence to be used in criminal and civil trials, identify natural diseases that may affect family members, and provide further information that can help the decedent's family process their grief.

Slightly more than 8% of all deaths will have a forensic autopsy, which is a postmortem examination of a decedent whose death falls under the jurisdiction of the medical examiner. A forensic autopsy is a component of the medicolegal death investigation that can be utilized to identify the decedent, assist in determining the cause and manner of death, identify additional factors that contributed to death, collect evidence to be used in criminal and civil trials, identify natural diseases that may affect family members, and provide further information that can help the decedent's family process their grief.
